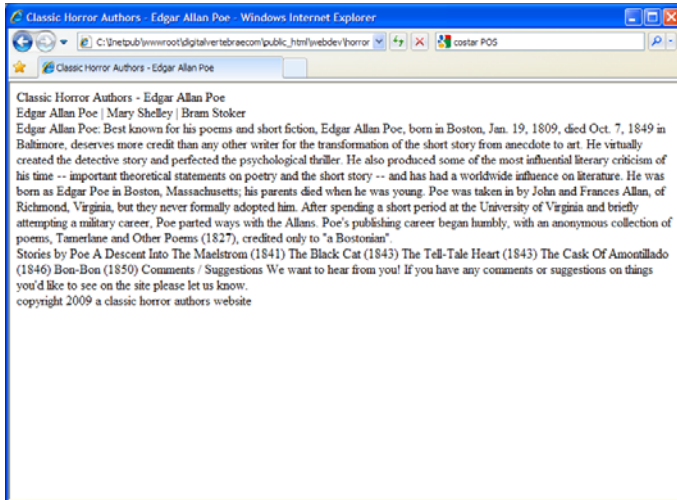

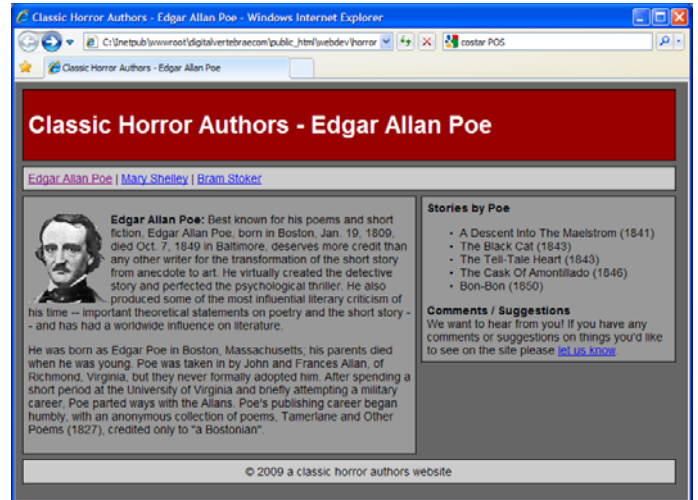
AN INTRODUCTION

CSS – Practice CSS Layouts

In this exercise you will have an opportunity to work through the challenges of laying out a web page using CSS. You will begin with the HTML file that will appear as the one on the left and add all required HTML and CSS to produce the layout on the right.

Here are some additional details:

1. Divide the content using div tags into:
 - a. Header
 - b. Navigation
 - c. Content
 - d. Rightpanel
 - e. Footer
2. The overall page should:
 - a. Have a Background color set to 666666
 - b. Use the font families Arial, Helvetica, Sans-Serif
 - c. Have a font size of 90%
3. All divs should:
 - a. Have a top margin of 6 pixels
 - b. Padding of 6 pixels
 - c. A 1 pixel solid black border
4. The header div should:
 - a. Have a background color of 990000
 - b. Have a width of 779 pixels
5. The navigation div should:
 - a. Have a background color of CCCCCC
 - b. Have a width of 779 pixels
6. The footer div should:
 - a. Have a background color of CCCCCC
 - b. Have a width of 779 pixels
 - c. Have a text alignment set to center
 - d. Use a style of **clear:left** (this will be new to you)
7. The content div should:
 - a. Have a background color of 999999
 - b. Have a width of 464 pixels
 - c. Have a bottom margin of 6 pixels
 - d. Float to the left of the rightpanel div
8. The rightpanel div should:
 - a. Have a background color of 999999
 - b. Have a width of 295 pixels
 - c. Have a left margin of 484 pixels
