For this exercise, you will be creating a short web page of biographical information on the classic horror author Edgar Allan Poe.

1. Open the template.htm document you created in Exercise 5 and save it as **exercise8.htm**
2. Enter the following between the <body> ... </body> tags.

Edgar Allan Poe, son of Actress Eliza Poe and Actor David Poe Jr., born 19th of January 1809, was mostly known for his poems and short tales and his literary criticism. He has been given credit for inventing the detective story and his psychological thrillers have been influences for many writers worldwide. In 1827 Edgar published his first book, "Tamerlane and other poems" anonymously under the signature "A Bostonian". The poems were heavily influenced from Byron and showed of a youthful attitude. 3. Using your knowledge of HTML tags, format the text so it appears in the browser window as illustrated below. You will want to do a portion at a time in Notepad, save it, and then view how the document appears in Internet Explorer. Remember to add "Edgar Allan Poe" as the heading and also as the title of your document in the head portion of your HTML source code.
