HTML – Creating Unordered and Ordered Lists

Exercise #9

For this exercise, you will be creating several ordered, unordered and nested lists and exploring the various attributes of the list tag.

1. Open the template.htm document you created in Exercise 5 and save it as **exercise9.htm**
2. Enter the following between the <body> ... </body> tags.

This is an unordered list

This is an ordered list

- List Item 1
- List Item 2
- List Item 3
- List Item 4

This is an ordered list starting at 10 and in upper-case roman numerals

- List Item 1
- List Item 2
- List Item 3
- List Item 4

This is an unordered list nested within an ordered list

- Walk the dog
- Wash the car
- Get groceries

- Ground beef
- Mozzarella
- Lasagna Noodles
- Pasta Sauce
- Ricotta Cheese

- Clean the house
- Take out garbage
